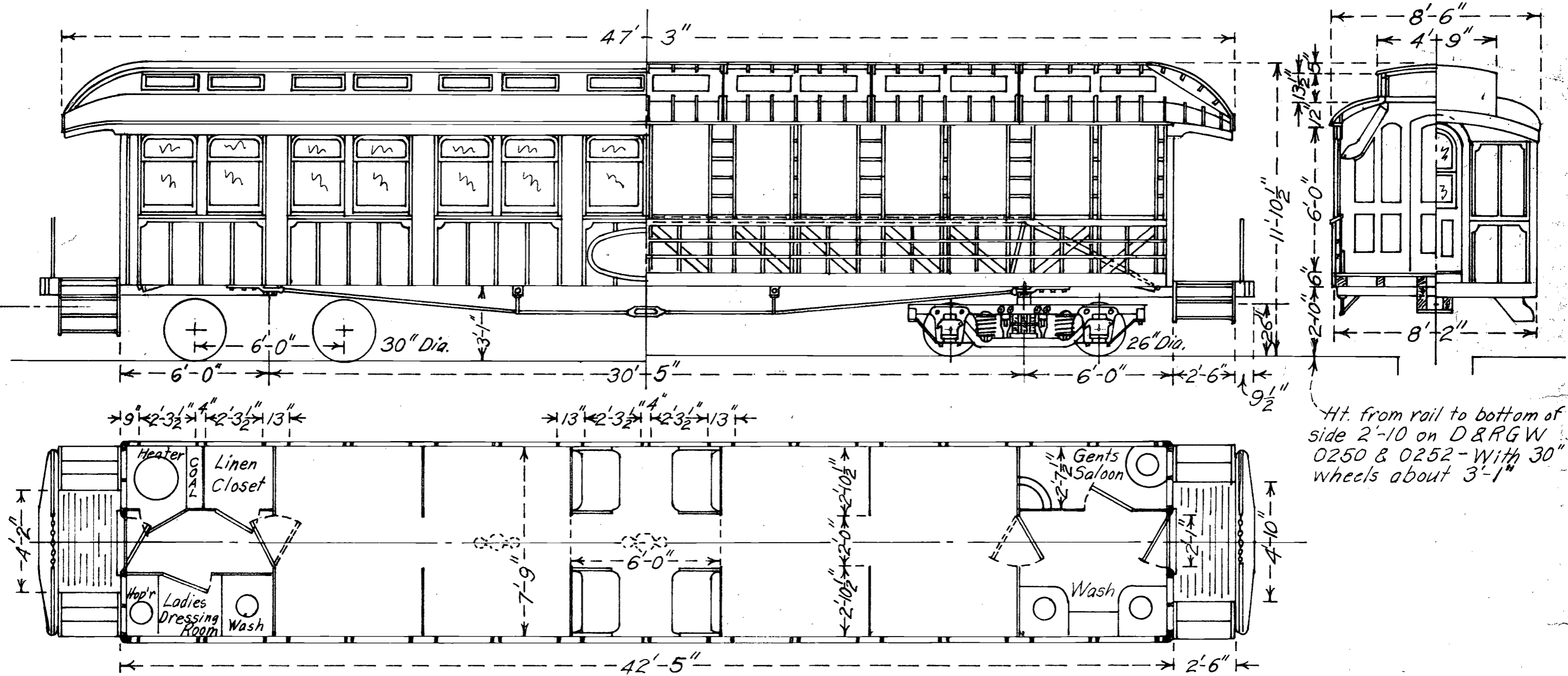


3-Foot Gauge

DENVER SOUTH PARK & PACIFIC Pullman built in Detroit-1879

Ht. from rail to bottom of side 2'-10" on D & R G W 0250 & 0252 - With 30" wheels about 3'-1"

Old D & R G W drawing shows end platform with 3 steps.

Cars originally painted "CHOCOLATE BROWN"; probably repainted "PULLMAN GREEN" by U.P. after January, 1881. 4 cars of this type acquired by Colo. & N. W. in 1899 as coaches seating 48. 2 cars sold by Morse Bros. 1920 to Western Union for use as Work Cars - these 2 cars sold to D & R G W 1937 & numbered 0250 & 0252

Drawing found by Dix Whatmuff in "NATIONAL CAR BUILDER" January 1880. Cars named "South Park," "Leadville," "San Juan," "Bonanza" & "Hortense."
